





His work has been nominated for an Olivier Award in London, a Helen Hayes Award in Washington, DC, and a San Francisco Bay Area Theatre Critic's

Circle Award. Along with his RSC partner Austin Tichenor, Reed was awarded the 2025 Sandra & Sidney Berger Award by the international Shakespeare Theatre Association which is presented annually to an Artistic Director in recognition of outstanding talent and dedication to the works of William Shakespeare.
